BUD & BLOOM

1. What is Bud & Bloom and what does it do?

Bud & Bloom is a specialized plant formula designed to enhance the growth of flowers and fruits. It contains nutrient-dense organic ingredients that provide natural minerals, nutrients, and growth promoters to your plants and soil. It's suitable for a wide range of plants, including Vegetables & Fruit Trees, Cactus, Tropical & Indoor Plants, Lawns, and Potted Plants.

2. How do I use Bud & Bloom for my plants?

There are several ways to use Bud & Bloom:

For new potting soils, mix 1/4 to 1/2 a cup of Bud & Bloom per 30L of potting soil.

As a top dressing for existing soils, apply 1/4 to 1/2 cup per 30L of soil or 1 to 2 cups per 1m² of garden bed. Scratch it into the soil's surface and water immediately.

For new plantings and fruiting plants, mix in 1/2 cup per planting hole and thoroughly blend with existing soil.

To create a botanical tea, use 1 heaped tablespoon per 5L of clean water. Agitate or add oxygen for 24 hours and water in afterward.

You can also create an all-purpose fertilizer blend by combining equal parts of Go & Grow + Bud & Bloom for a balanced NPK ratio.

3. Can I use Bud & Bloom for container plants?

Absolutely! For container plants, you can use Bud & Bloom by adding 1 heaped tablespoon to a 25L container of soil. This will provide nutrition for 2-3 weeks of growth.

4. What are the main ingredients in Bud & Bloom?

Bud & Bloom contains a mix of 100% organic ingredients, including Alfalfa meal, Neem meal, Coconut meal, Kelp meal, Seabird Guano, Gypsum, Rock Dust mix, Malted Barley, and Potash. The malted barley is chosen for its enzymes and nutritional content, and any grains that may not be fully malted can be mulched back into the soil.

5. What is the NPK ratio of Bud & Bloom?

When you combine Go & Grow with Bud & Bloom, the resulting NPK ratio is typically 2.5 – 2.5 – 3. This blend provides balanced nutrition for your plants' growth and development.

6. Can I use Bud & Bloom with TurboDirt?

Yes! Bud & Bloom can be used to provide an extra flowering boost to your existing plants that are potted in TurboDirt!

It can also be used to replenish nutrients back to the soil using the directions on the packaging.
