1. What is Go & Grow and what does it do?

3. How should I use Go & Grow for my plants?

Here are the recommended usage instructions for Go & Grow:

For new potting soils, mix 1/4 to 1/2 a cup of Go & Grow per 30L of potting soil.

As a top dressing for existing soils, apply 1/4 to 1/2 cup per 30L of soil or 1 to 2 cups per 1m² of garden bed. Ensure you scratch it into the soil's surface and water immediately for optimal results.

To nourish plants in containers, 1 heaped tablespoon of Go & Grow can sustain growth for 2-3 weeks in a 25L soil container.

When planting new or fruiting plants, mix 1/2 cup of Go & Grow into each planting hole and blend thoroughly with the existing soil.

To create a botanical tea, use 1 heaped tablespoon of Go & Grow per 5L of clean water. Continuously agitate or introduce oxygen to the mixture for 24 hours. Water your plants with the mixture immediately after the "brewing" process.

4. Can I combine Go & Grow with Bud & Bloom?

Yes, you can create a versatile All-Purpose Fertilizer Blend by combining equal parts of Go & Grow and Bud & Bloom. This blend typically results in an NPK ratio of 2.5 – 2.5 – 3, which provides balanced nutrition for your plants.

5. What are the main ingredients in Go & Grow?

Go & Grow contains a range of natural ingredients, including Alfalfa meal, Neem meal, Kelp meal, Malted Barley, Coconut meal, Soy meal, Gypsum, Lime, Rock Dust mix, Potash, and Seabird Guano.
